Ryan Bradley is the current US Figure Skating Men's National Champion. A fan favorite, with charisma to spare and jumps that defy gravity, Ryan always wows the crowds with his fun, exciting programs. After surgery on his broken foot in 2010, Ryan considered retiring, but much to the skating world's delight, he returned to skating to take the national title on his first competition of the season. His performance in the short program to "Boogie-Woogie Bugle Boy" set the bar high for US Nationals and is considered by many to be the defining moment of 2011 for the US Figure Skating Team. Ryan's amazing achievements and engaging personality inspire every skater who has the opportunity to work with him.

The winner of the prestigious Jimmy Disbrow Award for 2011, Phillip Mills has been a powerful force in the creative evolution of the sport of figure skating for over 27 years.
