Fan Favorite Ryan Bradley

Ryan Bradley is the current US Figure Skating Pewter Medalist. A fan favorite, with charisma to spare and jumps that defy gravity, Ryan always wows the crowds with his fun, exciting programs. This year at nationals, his tongue-in-cheek choreography to a classical melody, combined with awe-inspiring technique, gave him second in the long program for an overall fourth place standing. Ryan's goal for this season is to qualify for the World Championships.

Ryan Bradley was born on November 17, 1983, in St. Joseph, Missouri. Ryan began his skating career at the age of two. At five, he began training with Olympic coach Tom Zakrajsek. He landed a double axel, triple salchow and triple toe loop by the time he was nine years old. His parents, both figure skaters themselves, moved the family to Colorado Springs when Ryan was twelve years old to foster his talent. Ryan continues to represent the Broadmoor Skating Club, volunteering his time when he is not coaching or training at the World Arena, where he trains 35 hours per week. A business major at the University of Colorado-Colorado Springs, he enjoys reading, tennis, and video games.

Skating Icon Phillip Mills

Phillip Mills has been a powerful force in the creative evolution of the sport of figure skating for over 25 years. He has choreographed some of the most memorable skating routines for more than 18 U.S. National Champions in singles, pairs, and dance. He has also been faculty for Team USA Camps, U.S. Figure Skating Coaches College and numerous U.S. Figure Skating Judges Schools. This involvement keeps Phillip tuned into the continued and growing changes in figure skating.

Phillip has created acclaimed programs for the likes of Michelle Kwan, Sasha Cohen, Tara Lipinski, Rena Inoue & John Baldwin, Amber Corwin, Calla Urbanski & Rocky Marval, Nicole Bobek, Suzie Wynne & Joseph Druar, Elaine Zayak, and Jill Trenary just to name a few.
